

Thomas Jensen is solo flutist in South Jutland Symphony Orchestra (Denmark), and associate professor at The Royal Academy of Music in Århus (Denmark).

He received his first musical training in the Tivoli-Guards (Copenhagen) under the flutist Preben Rasmussen. Thereafter private studies with Eyvind Rafn. Masterclasses with Jean-Pierre Rampal.

Thomas Jensen has been awarded prizes at international flute competitions (Montreux and Paris) and has made a number of CD-recordings, including the flute concertos by Carl Nielsen and Jacques Ibert

He has appeared as soloist at concerts, and given masterclasses in Europe and the USA, and has conducted several orchestras in Denmark, Poland, Germany and Russia.
