

ΔiavloΣ Duo is one of Poland's leading chamber ensembles, featuring two award-winning soloists: Ewelina Zawiślak and Iwona Glinka. The duo has earned acclaim for their profound musicality, virtuosity, and exceptional harmoniousness of ensemble performance. Their concerts captivate audiences and they are renowned for their expressive performances.

The duo's name comes from the most popular ancient Greek wind instrument. The ΔiavloΣ consisted of two divergent pipes connected at the base. Each pipe had a separate mouthpiece and reeds (single or double). The flutist, with great skill and blowing loudly, achieved harmony and wonderful resonance with both flutes. The ΔiavloΣ, with its rich, intensely emotional, rhythmic, and penetrating sound, was capable of single-handedly accompanying the dances of dozens of men. ΔiavloΣ Duo has performed around 50 concerts together. The artists are laureates of international competitions and holders of scholarships from the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage and the KPO. The duo has received awards in the following music competitions: obtaining the highest score in the competition for the Diavlos Duo representing Łódź / London / England. European Classical Music Awards / 2025; Platinum award in the professional category for the Diavlos Duo for their LIVE performance of the Concerto "Aventures Coloristigues" for two flutes and orchestra by Greek composer Michail Travlos / London / England. European Classical Music Awards / 2025; Silver medal "Best Duo Instrumentalists" for their LIVE performance of the Concerto "Aventures Coloristigues" for two flutes and orchestra by Greek composer Michail Travlos / London / England. European Classical Music Awards / 2025; Platinum award in the professional category for the excellent live performance of the premiere of Michail Travlos's composition "Five Polish Dreamscapes" / London / England. European Classical Music Award / Awarded by the European Classical Music Awards Global Committee / 2024. In December 2025, the flutists of the ΔiavloΣ Duo ensemble released the CD "Homophony & Heterophony" for two solo flutes. The CD was released by the ARS SONORA record company (ARSO-CD-275). The artists featured on the CD are: Grażyna Bacewicz, Jerzy Bauer, Roman Ryterband, Michail Trvalos, Sławomir Kaczorowski, Krzysztof Grzeszczak, Marian Gordejuk, and Hanna Ważna. The recorded material allows for acquaintance with a wide spectrum of sound and expressive possibilities of the flute and its varieties. The compositions utilize extended performance techniques, which are an integral part of the expanded sound structures of the parts, allowing for the consolidation of playing techniques essential to the contemporary flautist's craft.



*"The pieces recorded on the CD represent a summary of the musical experiences, explorations, and artistic interests of the ΔiavloΣΔuo ensemble. The selection of recorded works for two solo flutes also reflects their interest in Polish and international literature. The compositions recorded on the CD required the flutists to master the instrument perfectly, from the diverse sonic, dynamic, and articulatory qualities, through the high degree of manual difficulty in very fast passages and high registers, and to control the intonation of each register. The artists thoroughly considered the performance art, formal structure, and inspiration stemming from cultural traditions and experimentation."*
