

Jeroen Bron studied at the Royal Conservatoire in The Hague. After graduating from the Young Talent department he continued on to the senior department where he studied with Rien de Reede and Thies Roorda from 1990 to 1996. He completed his conservatoire training with 3 years as a postgraduate, studying with Emily Beynon.

In addition he has also taken masterclasses with Trevor Wye, William Bennett en Peter Lukas Graf amongst others and in 1995 won first prize in the Kuhlau International Chamber music competition in Germany.

During his studies Jeroen already began to specialise in teaching young, talented flute players and has been a flute teacher at the Royal Conservatoire in The Hague since 1999, teaching in both the Young Talent and senior departments, including several years in collaboration with Emily Beynon.

Since the start of the Neflac (Netherlands Flute Academy) in 2009, Jeroen has been part of the staff as a flute teacher, conductor and arranger. Since 2021 he is the artistic and pedagocial director together with Wieke Karsten.
